April Blossom 12 Car Rally – Friday 25th April 2008

Thank you for your entry your start number is as per the entry list below.

Please report to the start at Birchanger Services Car Park, A120 /M11 junction, MR 167/513216

Signing on will start from 7.45pm, Beginners will receive their clues 15 minutes before their due start time.

Car 1 will leave the start at 20:31 hours

This route uses roads that we do not get to use that often and it is essential that we do not cause issues in locations that might be surprised to have 12 cars passing through. Whilst many of the roads are excellent, a number of new speed restrictions have crept in to both Hertfordshire and Essex indeed some have appeared since the original recce! You will be going through some villages and regrettably short sections of both A and B roads that I would not normally use. Two of the sections TC 8 - 9 and TC 12 -13 are timed very slackly and although standard you will have no boards to record. Please use these slack sections to make up the time permitted on the timecard but do not speed through them unnecessarily.

There is no need for excessive speed or to deviate from the road surface and make unplanned visits to parts of the Essex countryside, or if you do, please have consideration for both residents and organisers of later events who may wish to use the area subsequently.

Quiet Zones

All 30mph and 40mph areas and MTC1 - TC2, TC8 - 9, TC12 - 13, TC14 - MTC15 are to be treated as quiet zones in their entirety, plus

Please DO NOT use spot lights or excessive noise in any of these above areas nor approaching or leaving bends and junctions where there are houses. Please drive quietly and sensibly in all such areas.

The Driving Standards Observer will be out, not necessarily in the locations listed, and will report offenders.

There are one or more LWRs, Long Way Round the grass triangles in the middle of road junctions. Some may have code boards the correct way round, some will have nothing and are there to slow you down. There will be no LWR near housing.

Note 167/5123 is Not as Map - building work has created a 'T' junction, just turn left.

Your start time will be shown in the third box to the right of the Start control. Your due time at future controls will be shown in the third box to the right of the relevant control. If you have been late at an earlier time control (i.e. you have moved along the card to the right) and arrive early at a control you may make up some of the time by moving back to the left but no more than the number of minutes specified in the 'Make Up' column of the timecard.

Code boards should be recorded in the boxes on the timecard. Marshals will counter-sign empty boxes on the timecard.

Please remember that you MUST wait outside the control area if you arrive early.

You will be timed as you pass the control board
