### Proposed Training Calendar

The below is a planned programme of road rally navigation training and events that will hopefully address the needs of members at various levels of expertise and should prepare them to compete in the Pheasant Plucker road rally that is currently being considered for March 2010, perhaps double points? (to be discussed and agreed at Committee).

One goal is to agree 8 different types of clues that will be adopted by all 12 car organisers. Each clue type will have a different degree of difficulty that reflects the relevant navigation classes of beginner/Novice, Semi-Expert and Expert. By applying the same clue types and exposing members to the variations class during the training programme we should ensure that all navigators will never be faced with a clue they have not seen before and that they know the tips on how to work them out. Furthermore there will also be a planned education programme and exposure to clues of the next level of difficulty so that navigators are then not fazed with the prospect of going up a class.

We will update who will be instructing as and when we get more volunteers, we can also change the order of training based upon your feedback.
