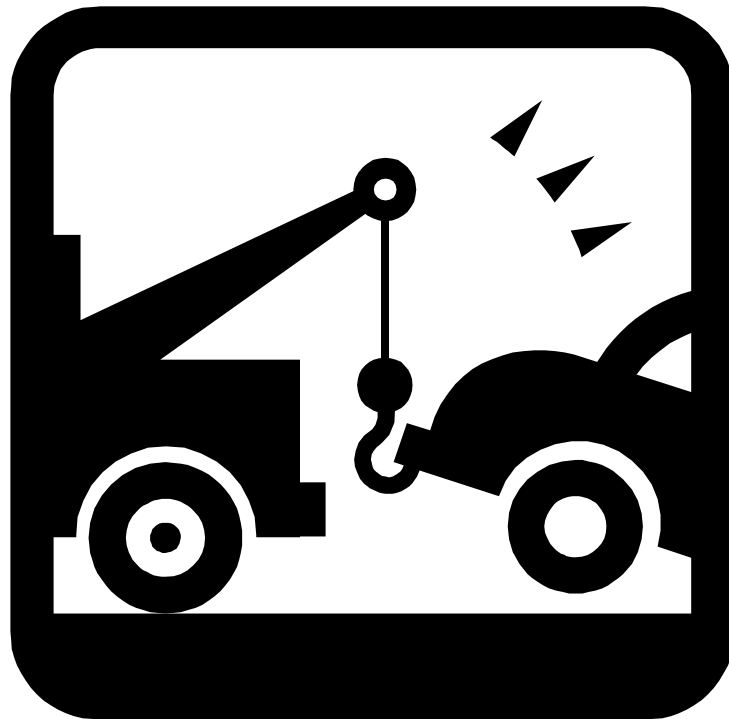


SEAXES TABLTOP AND NAVIGATIONAL
[STAN'S]
RALLY
(no car required)



21st AUGUST 2008

1. Status

The Motor Sport Club of Chelmsford Ltd will organise a Table Top Rally on Thursday August 21st 2008 at the Essex Regiment Way Golf Centre, Pratts Farm Lane, Little Waltham, Chelmsford CM3 3PR [MR 684120].

The event will take approximately 2 hours between 8pm and 10.30pm.

2. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motor Sports Aresilly Ltd., incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the CIA, these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the organising team may think up.

3. Authorisation

RACMSA permit number:- Not required so there!

4. Eligibility

The event is open to

- a) All fully elected members of the organising Club
- b) All fully elected members of any other Club who thinks CMC is a good club.
- c) All fully elected members of MENSA [NOT!]

5. Proof of Membership

All competitors must produce a valid Club membership card or £10 note which will be inspected/seized at signing on.

6. Championship

The event is a round of the Chelmsford Motor Club 12 car rally championship.

7. Details of Event

The start, finish and duration of the event will be at the Essex Regiment Way Golf Club, Pratts Farm Lane, Little Waltham, Chelmsford CM3 3PR [MR 684120].

No petrol will be required to complete this event but driver and navigator fuel will be available throughout.

Total distance covered will be approximately 4' 4" [1.32m]. [Distance travelling to and from the bar and competitor relief areas are excluded. All roads may be used and will be expressly specified in individual route instructions.

Competitor scrutineering and signing on will start at 7.30pm to 8.30pm. Any competitor not signed on by 8.30pm will not be allowed to start. Competitors can start at any time between 8.00pm and 8.30pm. Any competitor wearing any loud or offensive clothing may be excluded.

Latest versions of OS maps 167C [Chelmsford, Harlow and Bishops Stortford].

Competitors will also require a romer, pencil, rubber and ruler. A compass and tracing paper is recommended but not essential.

Codeboards will consist of 36 number plate letters on a black background.

8. Classes

Classes will be as 12 Car Championship.

Priority will be given to Beginners and Novices. In the event of a competitors class being subject of dispute, the Competition Secretary's decision is final.

9. Awards

10. Entries

The maximum number of entries is 25 plus 3 reserves. Under no circumstances will more than 500 competitors be allowed to start.

11. Entry List

The entry list opens on publication of these SR's and closes at 10pm on Wednesday 20th August 2008. The entry fee is £5.00. Late entries may be accepted at the organisers discretion.

13. Results

Provisional results will be announced in accordance with B13.1(b). Protests must be made in accordance with E 7.1.6. Final results will be provided to the Competition Secretary within 7 days.

14. Route Definition

All competitors will be issued with their clues as they book in at the 'Out' control.

Directions of approach and/or leaving may be affixed to a map reference. E.G. SE 123456 NW, means approach from the South East and leave travelling North West.

15. Give Way Junctions

Give Way door entrances [GW] may be marked in addition to all standing Give Way and Stop doorways. Observers may be situated in Quiet zones/sensitive areas and at competitor relief areas. All competitors MUST stop at the bar.

16. Quiet Zones

Quiet zones/sensitive areas may be marked within the start/finish venue and within 500m of the venue. A 'SHUSH' noise or even 'SHUT UP' may be used by Judges of Fact. This may be accompanied by a 'Please' word, depending on the volume of noise created.

17. Timing

For all sections, BBC timing will be used, Mickey's big hand is the hour and his small hand denotes the minutes. Competitors will know their start time and the time allowed for each section will be specified in the time card/road book. A competitors due time at each control can be determined from the individual time schedule. If you are late you can only make up time in the sections specified on the time sheet. Competitors can wait in the control for their correct time if they arrive early.
