## AUTUMN AUTOTEST 6<sup>th</sup> October 2007



The Motor Sport Club of Chelmsford Ltd. will organise a dual permit, sealed surface Clubsport & Production Car Autotest on **Saturday** 6<sup>th</sup> October 2007@ MOD Woodbridge Airfield, near Ipswich, MR **169/322478** with kind permission of the Defence Estates and the Station Staff Officer at MOD Woodbridge.

It is hoped that this will become a regular event in the local Motorsport calendar, attracting existing competitors and newcomers to the Autotest discipline.

- 1) The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 2) The MSA permits for this event will be available on the official notice board
- 3) The event is open to all full members of the organising club and the following invited clubs: Eastern Counties MC, Falcon MC, Sporting Car Club of Norfolk, Weald MC, West Suffolk MC, and Wickford AC. Membership cards must be produced at signing on.
- 4) The programme for the meeting will be:-

Scrutineering 09.30 – 10.30 Signing on by 10.30 Competitors Briefing 10.45 First Test 11.00

- 5) The event will consist of 5 classes split as follows:-
  - A Small FWD cars less than 12 foot (Mini, Fiesta, Nova etc.)
  - B Large FWD cars over 12 foot (Cavalier, Astra, Escort etc.)
  - C All standard RWD cars
  - D 4x4 / Rally/ Autocross Car, Kit Car & Specials or non-free differential(s).
  - E Production Car Autotest; Drivers Aged 14-16, cars max. 1600cc
- 6) All vehicles must be of sound and safe construction, which will be checked at scrutineering.
- 7) Awards will be presented as follows:-
  - Fastest time of the day (not eligible for any other award)
  - First in each class
  - Best Novice (defined as competing in less than three Autotests without winning an award)
- 8) The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2007. **Vehicle passes will be issued in advance to competitors, to allow access to the venue, which should be presented upon request at the venue gate.** Entry fee is £17.50 cheques will not be cashed until after the event. Withdrawn entries, if notified by Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> October, will not be cashed, and after that at the organisers discretion. **So there are no excuses to delaying your entry.** The maximum entry is 60, the minimum is 15.
- 9) All official information will be conveyed by email, or if, by preferred post.

- 11) Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event. Any protests must be handed to the Clerk of the Course within 15 minutes of their announcement in accordance with section O of the Blue Book.
- 12) Test details will be given out at signing on. Competitors are recommended to walk the tests. Passengers are not allowed, except for competitors in the Production Car Autotest where a passenger **MUST** be present for **ALL** tests. For safety all hub caps or wheel trims of competing cars must be removed (E12.8.3)
- 13) There will be two test sites, with 4 different tests planned on each. Each driver will have two runs at each test best time only to count. Penalties are as per Blue Book, F 7.2.2 table F1 except for (D) + 5 seconds autotests striking a barrier, wall pylon or crossing test boundary (per mistake). Production Car Autotest, not attempting or being ready to attempt a test when requested to do so (C), not performing a test correctly other than (D) (E) and not completing a test or making a false start + 30 seconds. Timing will be by hand held watches to 0.1 seconds.
- 14) Competitors may be identified with numbers supplied by the organisers.
- 15) All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written with the exception of: (a) Posts / Pylons may be less than 1m high. (b) Car derived commercials, battery powered, unregistered and untaxed vehicles are allowed. (c) Practising the tests is forbidden.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

We shall be sharing the venue with Javelin Motorsport, who are running a Track Day. Please carefully follow the directions on the map which will be provided along with your vehicle pass, to take you to our location & stay within the agreed area.

Toilet facilities have been arranged with Javelin Motorsport, who also have catering arrangements in the form of a good quality 'Chuck Wagon'. These will be located within 5 minutes walk of our location, so please use them.
