

**WEST SUFFOLK MOTOR CLUB LIMITED**

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. The West Suffolk Motor Club will organise a Clubsport Permit Car Trial on **Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2008** at Wattisfield Hall Farm, Wattisfield, Suffolk. Map Reference: 144/008738 (the site will be arrowed from the A143 in Wattisfield)
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit No – To be advised
4. The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the organising club and fully elected members of Eastern Counties MC, Chelmsford MC, Cambridge Car Club, Falcon MC, Kings Lynn and District MC and Sporting Car Club of Norfolk.
5. All drivers must produce a valid club membership card.
6. The programme of the meeting will be:  
Scrutineering 09.00am  
First Car 10.00am  
Any competitor not signed on by 10.00 am may be excluded.
7. Public Roads will not be used to link sections; there will be at least 25 sections on private land. The entry may be split into groups to start at different hills.
8. The event will consist of three classes as follows:  
  
CLASS A – Front wheel drive  
CLASS B – Rear engined cars  
CLASS C – Open sports and kit cars and those cars excluded from the other classes, also cars with LSD may be subject to handicap.
9. All classes must comply with MSA technical Regulations except for the following which have been modified:  
  
M5 8 1 Vehicles need not be currently registered or taxed due to the event taking place solely on private land  
M7 3 1 Valances and skirts may be removed  
M7 4 Engines, Diffs, Carburettors and Gearboxes may be varied from standard but must be from the same model range

M7 7            Wheel and tyre sizes may be varied from standard. Winter pattern tyres will not be allowed. The organisers reserve the right to alter tyre pressures before and during the event to account for weather conditions and fair competition.

10. Awards will be as follows:

First Overall – an award  
First in Class – an award  
Second in Class – an award (subject to 5 starters)

11. The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes finally on MONDAY 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008. The entry fee is £17.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. NO LATE ENTRIES.

Should any of the above figures not be reached, then the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees will be refunded if non-starters are advised by 9.00 on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2008, thereafter at organisers discretion.

20. Use of the venue is dependent on the good behaviour of the competitors. The grass must not be damaged in the paddock or between the sections. No handbrake turns or deliberate wheel spins. No fuel or oil must be spilt and a ground sheet is required for servicing.
