Additional Supplementary Regulations

- 1 The Falcon Motor Club Ltd will organize a duel permit Clubsport / Production Car Autotest on thSeptember 2010 at Brays Warren, 165 Biggleswade Road, Upper Caldecot, Biggleswade, Beds. SG18 9BD Map Ref. 153/175461.
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sport Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), the Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organizing Club may issue for the event.
- 3 MSA Permit numbers 60190 & 60191 have been issued.
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of the Falcon Motor Club, Bedford Car Club, Chelmsford Motor Club, Green Belt Motor Club, Civil Service Motoring Association and Middlesex County Automobile Club.
- 5 All competitors must produce a valid membership card.

All competitors in the Production Car event must produce a valid MOT certificate and insurance certificate.
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 09.30am (any competitor not signed on by 10.15am may be excluded).
The first car will start at 10.30am
- 7 The Clubsport event will consist of four classes as follows:
 - (A) Engine over driven wheels up to 3744 mm long (12' ³/₄").
 - (B) Engine over driven wheels over 3744 mm long (12' ³/₄").
Overall length to include bumpers whether fitted or not.
 - (C) Front engine, rear wheel drive saloons.
 - (D) Sports cars, kit cars and specials.

The Production Car event will consist of two classes as follows:-

- P1) Competitor's aged 14,15,16 years of age and those who do not hold a full RTA License (B 8.3.5). The passenger must hold a full RTA license and be experienced in Autotesting (F9.2.1). Attention is drawn to B 9.3.8. A parent or guardian must Countersign the entry form of a competitor who is under 18 years of age.
- (P2) Drivers over 17 years of age competing with a passenger.

All cars competing in the Production Class must be saloon cars as defined in General Regulations F9.2.2 and be registered and taxed.

- 8 All cars must comply with the Technical Regulations. Except the following which has been modified: F 11.8.1 need not be registered or taxed.
- 8a Your attention is drawn to the following regulations: F11.5(E12.17), F 11.6(01.5.1),
- 9 Awards will be presented as follows and will be perpetual.

FTD
First in Class
Second in Class (subject to 4 starters)
Third in Class (subject to 6 starters)
Best Novice (subject to 3 starters)

Awards will be presented at the end of the event following publication of the results.

10 The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes on Thursday 8th September 2010.

The entry fee is:-

Production Car £15.50 if received by Thursday 8th September 2010.

Clubsport £17.00 if received by Thursday 8th September 2010.

Junior members £5.00 (up to 18 years old).

Late entries will be accepted at a fee of £20.00 up to 10.00 am on Sunday 12 September, provided notice has been telephoned / emailed to the Secretary of the meeting prior to the day. NOTE: A full refund will be given if entry is withdrawn up to the day before the event (before 9pm).

All entries must be made on the official entry form completed in full and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

17 Practicing will not be allowed.

18 All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except, that as the event takes place on private land, and Pylons may be less than 1 meter high.

19 Marking and penalties will be as printed in the General Regulations.

20 A car may be entered more than once in the same class provided that it is driven by different drivers on each occasion

21 Toilet facilities will be available on site.

22 There will be no catering at the event so bring your own food.
