

2024-2025 Essex & Suffolk AMSC Winter 12 Car Series Rules:

- 1) The Winter Series championship shall run from September 2024 to April 2025 and will include up to six AMSC rallies held under a 12 Car permit. As this is a navigational activity, there will be championship tables for each class for navigators, and one overall table for drivers. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the committee will be final.
- 2) At the end of the season, the results from the number of eligible events minus 1, will count. For example, if 6 events are eligible, the best scores from 5 will count. Points for marshalling will not be deducted from the final score.
- 3) Trophies will be awarded for 1st overall and 1st and 2nd in each class for navigators, and to the top 3 drivers. In the event of a draw those having the greatest number of maximum scores on events competed on (i.e. not including marshal points) will benefit, if still tied the number of second places will be considered and so on until the tie is resolved. If still tied the Championship Coordinator will resolve the issue.
- 4) Those members who the Championship Coordinator deems to be of a very high navigational ability (e.g. Master) will not be eligible to appear in the winter series result tables, but will not deny points from an eligible person navigating on an event with them.
- 5) The Championship Coordinator will maintain a list of contenders and their class eligibility on the web site throughout the year, which competitors should consult before entering. If you are not yet in the list, contact the Championship Coordinator with details of your experience before your first event.
- 6) Navigators will score points for the championship in the class in which they started the season regardless of any class upgrading achieved, but must enter each event in their current class.
- 7) Winter Series points will be awarded to members of AMSC clubs as follows
 - 12 points for finishing 1st, down to 1 point for finishing 12th or lower on each 12 car and any eligible handicapped event (e.g. 12 Car Navigational Exercises with different navigation for each class).
 - 12 points for 1st in class down to 1 point for 12th in class or lower on any eligible non-handicapped event (e.g. Road Rally).
 - 6 points for the first event on which an individual marshals.
 - 12 points for the first event on which an individual organises (as CoC/Secretary).
