



## Chelmsford Motor Club invites you to the East Anglian Classic Historic Rally

*Supporting the East Anglian Air Ambulance*

**Saturday/Sunday 20th-21<sup>st</sup> June 2026**



Following the success of the 2025 East Anglian Classic as a two-day event we are repeating the format. This means that crews travelling from up to five hours away can leave home on Saturday morning and be back home by Sunday evening.



The proposed schedule has scrutineering and signing-on from 11 am – 2 pm Saturday. The Saturday leg will start at 3.30pm and include around 70 miles of public road and off-road regularity, with several special tests before returning to the start venue for a barbecue supper around 8pm. This leg will take us back to some of our traditional rally venues in the Thetford, Norfolk area which we have not visited for a few

years. On Sunday we will re-start after breakfast at 9 am, with a further 80-90 miles of regularity, a coffee halt and more tests, finishing around 2.30 with a traditional Sunday lunch and awards presentation.



For our start and finish venue, including signing on, we have secured the use of Bury St Edmunds Rugby Club which has sufficient parking for all competitors and officials. Crews will need to make their own accommodation arrangements at one of the many hotels and B&Bs in the Bury St Edmunds area. Some things however are still just as you've come to expect:

- Same experienced organising and results team, albeit with a new Clerk of the Course
- Straightforward yet challenging navigation with plenty of pre-plot time
- 'Sting in the tail' plot 'n' bash section(s)
- Well-designed and laid out special tests on a variety of surfaces
- Mixture of public road and private land regularities
- Our usual friendly, competent and experienced marshals
- Clubman permit 'Run' for competitors with RS clubman licences
- Clubman permit 'Challenge' consisting of Saturday leg only
