# The Preston 2013

### **Final Instructions**

Welcome to the 35<sup>TH</sup> running of the "One and Only" Preston Rally. Whether you are the driver or navigator please read these instructions IN FULL. You should also print these instructions and bring them with you to the Start.

Your Start Number is shown on the above entry list. However, please note that we reserve the right to alter the seeding should this be necessary. Your Start Number will be confirmed at the Noise Check.

'The Preston' is once again supporting the The East Anglian Air Ambulance which is a charitable trust. It covers one of the most spread out populations of England and costs around £1m a year to run and has recently moved to 24x7 operations. Our excellent Start venue is the service centre for the East of England Ambulance Service and is being made available to us once more. Obviously we hope that their services will <u>not</u> be required on our event. The fact that 'The Preston' supports The Air Ambulance (i.e., giving money!!) has been influential in many landowners making the decision to allow us to use their tracks and long may this continue to do so. As you will know without the extensive use of private land 'The Preston' would not run'. Therefore a big plea! At the Start, even though Chelmsford Motor Club will be donating £10 from the entry fee for each crew starting the event to the Air Ambulance, there will also be collection buckets. Please put some cash in them, folding money is always best! Also please sign the Gift Aid form as this allows the Charity to reclaim the tax paid.

This year the Little Chef company are celebrating their 55<sup>th</sup> anniversary and have been tasked to do something in each restaurant to recognise this milestone. The Little Chef at Barton Mills (opposite the start), have sponsored a section on our event and for the week leading up to the Preston they are also undertaking fund raising in support of the East Anglain Air Ambulance. So with their help, your contribution and a contribution for Chelmsford Motor Club, we should achieve a bumper donation this year. In a show of support if you arrive early please consider using the Little Chef for food and refleshments.

Please note that as these finals are published on the Internet, more detailed information relevant to the event will be provided at signing on.

#### 7. Details of Event

#### 7.1 Time schedule

Noise / horn / wipers test: 18.20 - 20.20. Your due time is 18:20 + Car Number (see attached entry list and above). **Be on time! Not early, not late, but on time**. Scrutineering: 18.30 - 20.30 Signing on 18.40 - 20.45. Reserves from 20.30 Compulsory competitors briefing at **2100 prompt** in the signing-on room Event Start, MTC1: 22.01 (Car '1')

All Competitors must visit Noise Check first, Do NOT go to the Start venue first, not even briefly.

#### 7.2 Noise Test:

This is situated in the large lay-by on the right side of the A1065 Brandon road, approx 500m from the Five Lanes roundabout. Please enter at the far (northern) end and take care when turning into and exiting the layby. (please see plan)

#### 7.3 Trailers:

These are to be unloaded at the new finish venue, A11 - Elveden Estate Restaurant (MR 144/822801). Please see the plan for trailer parking. This venue is approx 8 miles from the Five Lanes roundabout, please park

trailers before going to Noise Test. At Elveden cross roads (Traffic Lights) turn left onto B1106 towards Brandon, after 400m turn right, will be arrowed and follow the trailer park diagram.

#### 7.4 Noise to the Start:

Turn left out of the Noise Test lay-by to Five Lanes roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit - A11 sign posted Newmarket. This is dual carriageway and the Start is on the *opposite* carriageway after 250 metres. Go past the Start and turn right, signposted Barton Mills. **Do not do a u-turn on the A11**. Go across the other carriageway as if into the village and then do a U-Turn. Come back to A11 and turn left (GW), towards the Start.

#### 7.5 Start Venue:

Enter venue (from A11) with care. Follow the attached diagram precisely - get fuel first (after Noise, but before Scrutineering). Leg 1 mileage information will be issued at the Noise Test. Please note and observe the one-way system in operation at the Start venue. Opposite side of the A11 to the Start venue is a Little Chef Restaurant, and there will also be a 'hot dog type catering van' in attendance at the Start. Please patronise these facilities.

#### 7.6 Cleanliness:

NO LITTER at Start, Rest Halt or Finish venues. PLEASE DO NOT LET US DOWN ON THIS. Breakfast is included in the entry fee this year. You will be given a 'breakfast ticket' upon arrival at the Finish (even if you have retired) in exchange for your Damage Declaration. And finally, The Preston is a club level event run by, and for, true enthusiasts; it survives because of the support of the sponsor(s) / organising club / event organisers / marshals / landowners and numerous others, so please remember, even if things go wrong, that everybody involved on this event is giving up their time voluntarily so you can have some fun.

#### 8 Entries

- 8.1 Please advise the Entries Secretary as soon as possible of any missing details concerning your entry, or if you have to make any changes, or if you have to withdraw.
- 8.2 Competition licenses. For those entrants who do not have a current MSA competition license <u>we will accept</u> <u>completed application forms with a passport size photograph and the appropriate fee.</u> Anyone who wishes to avail themselves of this facility and have not come prepared as stated above will not be allowed to start.

#### 17(iv) OTL

Maximum permitted penalty-free lateness will be 30 minutes & 59 seconds at all controls (i.e. 'OTL' time is 31 minutes) except the final control which will be 45 minutes and 59 seconds.

#### 21 Scrutineering:

Scrutineering will be efficient, so be ready and on time.

<u>Vehicles will fail scrutineering unless presented in a clean condition.</u> Bring your vehicle's MOT certificate and Registration document (V5) and make sure it is taxed for December!, we are entitled to check them and will do so.

All competitors are required to carry at least one sponge and a minimum of 1.5 litres of water for the purpose of cleaning car lights and registration number plates during the event. This will be checked at Scrutineering.

All competitors are strongly advised to use knobbly tyres on this event.

#### Other information:

The A11 is undergoing major improvement works and there are speed limits in force. There is a speed limit on approach to the Start – please ensure absolute compliance as this is most likely to be actively monitored by Suffolk Police.

Only the 2 signed-on crew members may be carried in each competing car

Spectators are not at all welcome on this event; we are sorry to take this stance but we have good reason. There will be no spectator information whatsoever. Competitors, under no circumstances are you to bring or invite any persons to this event unless they are going to marshal. Competitors found doing so, or divulging route information, will be refused a start and excluded with no refund of entry fee.

Competitors receiving any assistance during the event from 'support crews' or 'service vehicles' WILL be excluded, banned permanently from The Preston, and reported to the MSA.

2<sup>nd</sup> Petrol halt is a BP Connect and they will have lots of staff on duty, serving hot drinks, hot food etc. You will have 30 minutes here and as timing is improved this year, you will have enough time to have a drink and eat if you wish. Please make use of these facilities.
