Final Instructions

Welcome to the 43rd running of the Preston Rally. Whether you are the driver or navigator please read these instructions IN FULL. You should also print these instructions and bring them with you to the Start.

Your Start Number is shown on the above entry list.

The Preston is once again supporting The East Anglian Air Ambulance which is a charitable trust. It covers one of the most spread out populations of England and costs around £1m a year to run and is now a twenty four hours, seven days a week operation. Our Start venue is the Snetterton circuit which provides for the large entry this year with secure trailer parking and very smart scrutineering bays. The fact that The Preston supports The Air Ambulance (i.e., giving money!!) has been influential in many landowners making the decision to allow us to use their tracks. As you will know without the extensive use of private land The Preston would not run. **Therefore a big plea! At the Start, even though Chelmsford Motor Club will be donating £10 from the entry fee for each crew starting the event to the Air Ambulance, there will also be collection buckets, you can now also use the QR code shown in the road book with your smart phone. Also please sign the Gift Aid form as this allows the Charity to reclaim the tax paid.**

Important note from our Recovery Co-Ordinator Dany Wheatley:

The rescue and recovery crews would like to wish you all a safe rally and fun in the mud! We will be out there to get you going again when the ruts just get too deep, or to the end of section if the situation is more terminal for you.

All the rescue crews also want to get home safe so please slow down when you see active rescue happening, we'll be in hi Viz vests when out of our cars, and flashing beacons will be on.

Don't let the red mist cloud your judgement, rescue crews are Judges of Fact and penalty 18 (xxiii), Driving without due care near recovery vehicle, can be enforced.

7. Details of Event

7.1 Time schedule

Noise / wipers test: 18.00 – 20.00. Your due time is 18:00 + Car Number (see attached entry list).

Be on time! Not early, not late, but on time.

Scrutineering: 18.05 – 20.30

Signing on: online.

Road Book/Rally Plates/ Final Final Instructions: **collect from Competitors Info Area** (please see notice board)

Event Start, MTC1: 21:31 (Car '1')

7.2 Noise Test:

This is situated at the Start as shown on the attached plan.

7.3 Trailers:

Must be parked in the designated area as shown on the attached plan.

7.4 Fuel:

Fuel is available at the excellent new service station built just outside the circuit, which is approachable from either direction of the A11 using the flyover.

7.5 Start Venue:

Enter venue (from A11) with care. Follow the attached diagram precisely.

Toilets are available in three locations at the circuit. Hot Food and Drink will be available in Tyrells restaurant open between 5pm and 8pm. Please make use of these facilities. **STRICTLY NO DOGS PERMITTED WITHIN SNETTERTON CIRCUIT**

7.6 Cleanliness:

NO LITTER at Start, Petrol halts or Finish venues. PLEASE DO NOT LET US DOWN ON THIS. Breakfast is included in the entry fee. You will be given a 'breakfast ticket' upon arrival at the Finish in exchange for your Damage Declaration, even if you have retired you can still have breakfast which will be available from approximately 6:30 a.m. until around 9:00 a.m.

And finally, The Preston is a club level event run by, and for, true enthusiasts; it survives because of the support of the sponsor / organising club / event organisers / marshals / landowners and numerous others, so please remember, even if things go wrong, that everybody involved on this event is giving up their time voluntarily so you can have some fun.

8 Entries

- 8.1 Please advise the Entries Secretary as soon as possible of any missing details concerning your entry, or if you have to make any changes, or if you have to withdraw.

10 OTL

Maximum permitted penalty-free lateness will be 30 minutes & 59 seconds at **ALL** controls (i.e., 'OTL' time is 31 minutes).

11 Control Procedure:

Section Starts: Pull up to the Marshal at the control board they will chip your timecard, sign, and release you at your requested time.

Marked PC, Passage Checks: Stop at the Control Board next to the marshal, give your car number and the marshal will reveal the two-letter code board, the marshal will record your car number, you record the code the marshal will not sign your timecard.

Marked RC , Route Checks: These will be forward facing 2 letter code boards write them in your time card, these maybe replaced by manned controls (passage checks as above)

Finish Controls: Stop at the control board the marshal will stop the clock. Pull forward sensibly to the marshal some distance ahead will chip your timecard, sign your timecard and record your time.

Before joining the public highway: Ensure your lights and number plates are clean and windows to a safe standard.

12 Scrutineering:

Scrutineering will be efficient, so be ready and on time.

Vehicles will fail scrutineering unless presented in a clean condition. Bring your vehicle's MOT certificate and Registration document (V5) and make sure it is taxed for December! By signing on you are responsible for ensuring that your vehicle is correctly taxed.

All competitors are required to carry at least one sponge and a minimum of 1.5 litres of water for the purpose of cleaning car lights and registration number plates during the event.

Tarpaulin or ground sheet to be placed under car at finish to stop mud falling on to surface. This will be checked at Scrutineering.

All competitors are strongly advised to use knobbly tyres on this event.

13 Face Covering:

Please adhere to all latest MSUK and government requirements. In all indoor settings facemasks should be worn unless seated to eat or drink.

14 Briefing:

There will be no verbal drivers briefing prior to the event. Final Final's will be issued with your roadbook on the night.

NOTE:

Only the 2 signed-on crew members may be carried in each competing car.

Spectators are not at all welcome on this event; we are sorry to take this stance but we have good reason. There will be no spectator information whatsoever. Competitors, under no circumstances are you to bring or invite any persons to this event unless they are going to marshal. Competitors found doing so, or divulging route information, will be refused a start and excluded with no refund of entry fee.

Competitors receiving any assistance during the event from 'support crews' or 'service vehicles' WILL be excluded and reported to the Motorsport UK.

The use of in-car video equipment is banned, any competitor found in contravention will be excluded from the event. The equipment will be confiscated and any recorded material destroyed.

Use of headsets is only permitted by crews where a member of that crew has a letter of dispensation from the Motorsport UK.

The mileage to first petrol is 68 miles

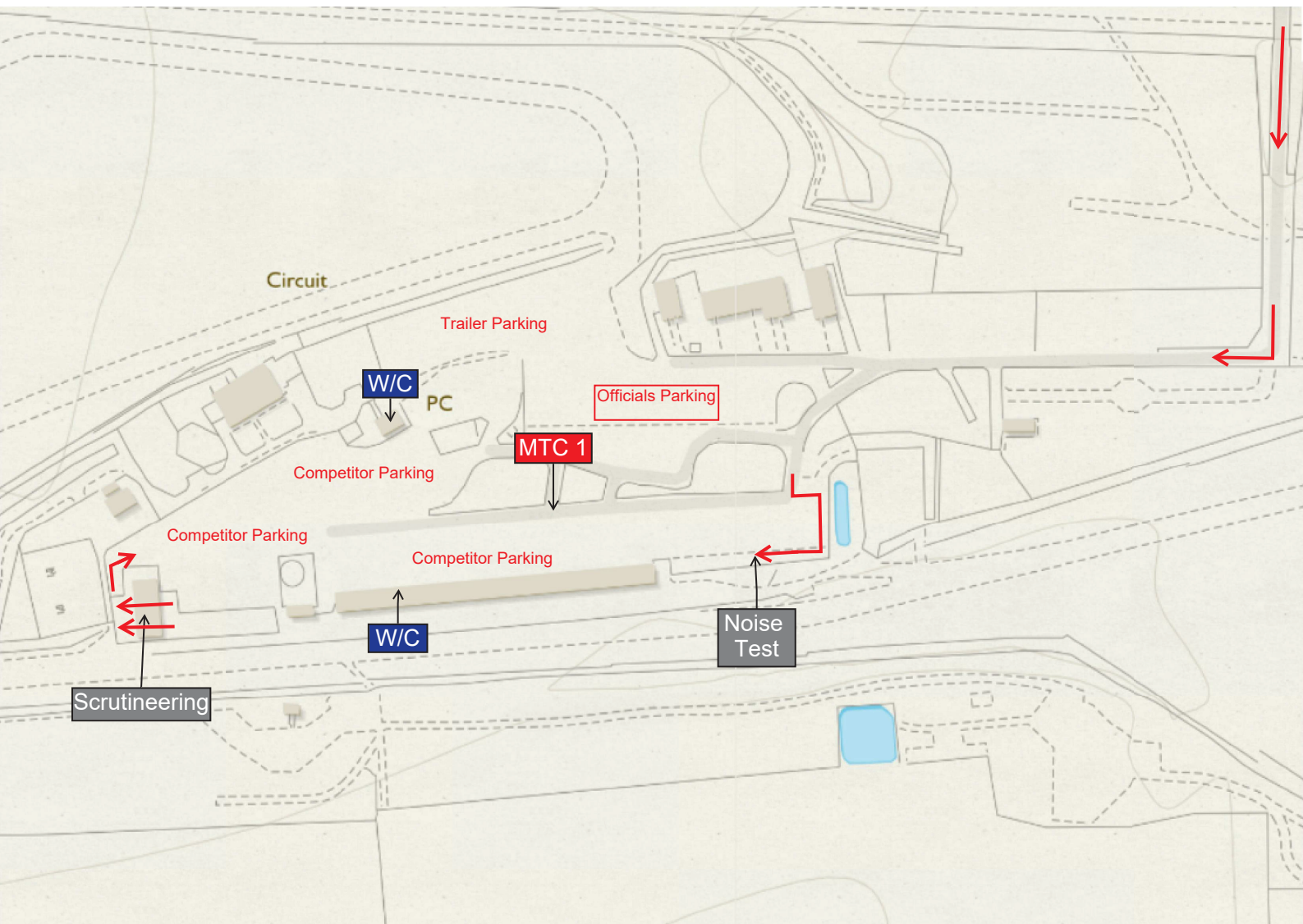
Petrol 1 to Petrol 2 mileage is 69 miles

1st Petrol halt is at the East bound BP garage on the A11 at Thetford. You will have 45 minutes here to fill up your water container and get petrol, if required. There will be staff on duty serving hot drinks, hot food etc. Please make use of these facilities.

2nd Petrol halt is at the West bound BP garage on the A11 at Thetford. You will have 40 minutes here to fill up your water container and get petrol, if required. There will be staff on duty serving hot drinks, hot food etc. Please make use of these facilities.
